Subject: Conversation with Mariana

Location: Telephone in office

Time: 6:39-6:56pm

Mariana called me on Monday night, around 8:30pm, to ask me to accompany her and Dr. Gordon on Friday to a meeting with the president of Rockland Community College to ask for support for their project. Specifically, they want students to volunteer with their parent education classes. I was to call her to let her know where to pick me up from the train station. I called her tonight, and we cleared up some misunderstandings.

Mariana wanted me to take over the Harlem piece of her project. She is doing a pilot study of 10-15 families in 3 areas: Rockland County, Harlem, and Morris County.

We began by cancelling the meeting tomorrow. I offered the times that the train arrives in Suffern, New York. She suggested that I go to a meeting with a church instead, so that I could see what was happening. [I'm still not sure what that is about.] She said that she needs to go to Ed's house first, and go with him, and that she doesn't know her way around Rockland. I told her that would be fine, I was surprised when she asked me to go, since that would be a high-level meeting. She continued by talking about the project.

Below are some pieces from our conversation, typed in real time:

M: One piece is in Rockland, over there, and Fabiola is going to be doing it The other thing is in Harlem. And when I'm going to do that in Harlem, *you* are going to be doing it. ... What is going to happen is, with our grant, we are going to get money for you. Research, what is it called, assistant research?

L: I don't have a lot of time [explain about other project]

M: Part of the grant, what's going to happen is, Have to find research assistant This person is going to be,

IUME, they they are *already* involved with Harlem's Children's Zone

Veronica, Veronica was talking about how she is working with children

From that group there are thousands of kids

We just need 10 or 15

Whoever this person is working with

We are going to be ?? reach with those 10 or 15 families

As we do this,

I know that they are going to have results because I know that

As we get results, we are going to be going for more funding to scale

Basically that is what is going to happen

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Next week,

I'm going to be meeting with Nancy Train

She is the vice president of Columbia University

She is the person who is going to be developing the relationships between the university and the schools

This program REACH is working with schools

From inside the schools

Using their resources

Using NCLB guidelines

They ask specifically for stuff that? NCLB

That the school should be doing but they are not, they are not

That way when we train the parents to influence the school

The school will be ??

Columbia is also going to be consulting the schools

You see?

By that time, we are going to be?

What I'm doing now, I'm doing in Morris County

## L: Where?

M: Basically we are picking 3 pilots
Going to be implemented in 3 diff environments
Morris County is urban env
Mainly Anglo American

The kids who are failing are mostly Latino and African American children

The other env New york, rockland, Suburban, Mostly African American

Harlem, basically urban

Both African American and Latino but I believe mainly African American

L: if you're looking for someone for next year
If I focus now on Morris County and Pomona

2008 we will say we begin Harlem
Maybe Veronica
She's already working with kids
And she's at IUME
She would be a good way to find somebody

L: I'm going to see Veronica next week

M: Can you ask her [to keep an eye out for a research assistant]

L: [Veronica will be good at that,] I'm just learning

M: We're learning

L: [hope that Mariana finds lots of student volunteers]
